Hundreds of job seekers attended the Fall Job Fair held September 22nd at the Paddock Mall.

Andrea Abrams, the CareerSource Citrus, Levy and Marion program coordinator who helped staff the event, said 376 people registered on site. Representatives from the College of Central Florida estimated there were about 500 attendees based on the number of give-aways.

The fair was put on by CF's XCEL-IT program in partnership with Career Source CLM, the Talent Center and the college. Thirty one local employers recruited by Abrams, attended the event, which took place in the center court in front of Macy's.

3cups sugar

1 cup vegetable oil

4 eggs

2/3 cup water

1(15oz) can pumpkin puree

2tsp grnd ginger

1 tsp grnd allspice

1tsp grnd cinnamon

1 tsp grnd cloves

3 1/2 cup flour

2 tsp baking soda

1 1/2 tsp salt

1/2 tsp baking powder

Directions:

Heat oven to 350 F.

Lightly grease two 9x5in loaf pans

In a large mixing bowl, combine sugar, oil and eggs, beat until smooth. Add water and beat until well blended. Stir in pumpkin, ginger, allspice, cinnamon and clove.

In medium bowl, combine flour, soda, salt and baking powder. Add dry ingredients to pumpkin mixture and blend just until all ingredients are mixed.

Divide the batter between prepared nans

Bake in preheated oven about 1 hour or until toothpick comes out clean.
